Our volunteer coaches and “buddies” will help the young athletes learn the game of soccer through a variety of fun soccer-themed activities appropriate to the ability and age of the players.

**At this time we can only accommodate players who do not use walkers/crutches/etc. For those ages and disabilities we are currently unable to accommodate, please accept our regrets. We aim to include children of all ages and disabilities in the future.*

Registration Fee of \$60.00 includes:

- *45 minute sessions

Space is limited to 20 players and there are no residency requirements.

***Players are to be no younger than five (5) and no older than seven (7) by 9/30/09.*
